Directions: Edit the following sentences for appropriate usage of the forward slash based on your understanding of section 8.4 of the *AMA Manual of Style*.

1. Gadofosveset trisodium was administered at a dose of 0.12 mL/kg of body weight.
2. The patient's pulse rate was 92 per minute.
3. Conventional albumin concentrations are reported in g/dL.
4. Physicians were required to be on call 3 d/wk.
5. Study participants were administered 50 mEq/L of sodium bicarbonate.
6. Survey data were collected from 1/1/12 to 1/1/13.
7. The male/female ratio was 2/1.
8. The mean (SD) LDL-C/HDL-C ratio was 3.96 (1.35).
9. The study examined academic performance in undergraduate obstetrics/gynecology clinical rotations.
10. An intern can perform the aspiration technique even if he/she has had no prior training in the procedure.
11. When Mr and Ms Smith arrived at the office, the receptionist asked whether he/she had made the appointment.
