Directions: *Acknowledgments* is the blanket term used to cover the information that follows the body of the article and precedes the references. The Acknowledgment section may contain information on date of acceptance of the manuscript, online publication date, correspondence address, author contributions, study group participants, financial disclosure, funding and support, role of the sponsor, independent statistical analysis, disclaimer, previous presentation, and other miscellaneous information. In the following examples, indicate in which section of the Acknowledgments the information belongs. Refer to section 2.10 of the *AMA Manual of Style* for guidance.

1. Final revision received May 1, 2014.

**Submitted for Publication:** November 22, 2004; final revision received May 13, 2005; accepted May 23, 2005.





**Disclaimer:** *The views expressed herein are those of the authors and do not necessarily reflect the views of the US Army or the Department of Defense.*

**Disclaimer:** *Use of trade names or names of commercial sources is for information only and does not imply endorsement by the US Public Health Service or the US Department of Health and Human Services.*

**ANSWER:**

Role of the Sponsor

**Editor's Note:** *The specific role of the funding organization or sponsor in each of the following should be specified: design and conduct of the study; collection, management, and analysis of the data; and preparation, review, and approval of the manuscript. For articles that do not include original research, "design and conduct of the study" is omitted.*

*Example is shown below:*

**Role of the Sponsor:** *The funding organizations are public institutions and had no role in the design and conduct of the study; collection, management, and analysis of the data; preparation, review, and approval of the manuscript; or decision to submit the manuscript for publication. The Utah and Missouri health departments provided practical support for the focus group and survey processes, including letters of endorsement, hospital contact information, and assistance with logistic arrangements for focus group sessions.*


