For greater uniformity in "technical requirements for manuscripts submitted to their journals," the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors, meeting in 1978 in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada, developed the Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals.
